

Healthy Living Tips

AFFIRMATION

I'd like you to write an affirmation (or two) for yourself that you will say all week. This affirmation will serve as a reminder to you of your strength, tenacity, drive, and resilience. This will serve as motivation for you to keep moving forward towards your goal.

I'd like you to take a few moments right now and think about your affirmation for the week.

Now, here is how you write an affirmation:

- 1. Choose a negative thought that you've told yourself repeatedly (whether you realize it or not). Something that you'd like to see changed in your life.
- 2. Start with "I". This is about YOU. No one else. Your positive changes will affect other people, of course, but this is all about you.
- 3. Use the present tense. Start writing "I AM..." or "I HAVE..." or something similar. We're not looking into the future. We're not thinking about the past. This is for RIGHT NOW! Other words you can use are Choose, Make,
- 4. Think about how you want that negative thought to be changed. Write a statement about the positive side of that negative thought.
- 5. Don't use ANY negative words. Saying "I will not smoke" isn't a great affirmation. Saying "I am free from smoking" or "I am proud of giving my lungs fresh, clean air" or something similar.
- 6. Avoid statements like "I want" or "I need". This is not the time to want or need. This is the time to manifest. Our statements are going to be those that manifest positive things in our lives.
- 7. Add Emotion. Give the statement some feeling. "I am excited about..." or "I feel happy that I..." Every time you speak this emotion, be sure to actually FEEL that emotion in that moment.
- 8. Say it out loud. Once you come up with your statement, say it out loud to yourself several times a day. And LISTEN to yourself as you are saying it. You need to hear you speak these words to yourself and about yourself.
- 9. **Say it like you mean it!!** Every time you speak these words, say it with ALL the excitement and enthusiasm that you can muster. Even if you don't believe it at the moment, continue to say it as such.

Now it is time to create your affirmation for the week. Don't overthink it. Just follow the rules and write it. Then say it.

Greetings Brothers,

Thank you for registering for the 2020 Conclave in Tampa, Florida. You are on the right side of history. Never in the history of Omega Conclaves have we received approximately 3,000 early-bird registrants for the Conclave in the first two weeks. This excitement to attend the Conclave is a great thing, and the planning committee is excited to host you. It is important to note that demand for housing is also greater than we anticipated; thus, some Brothers have found themselves unsuccessful at obtaining housing. The housing committee is working to secure more housing to accommodate our need. We are confident the committee will be able to do so.

It has been reported some Brothers didn't receive the housing link (sent via email or in the registration confirmation). We are looking into that process to ensure everything is working properly and that the link is more visible. Please be reminded that no more than one room can be booked per registration and any additional rooms booked or rooms booked by unregistered Brothers is subject to cancellation by Omega to allow for the maximum number of registered brothers to be accommodated.

Please be patient as the housing team secures more housing opportunities for the 500plus brothers seeking housing. If you are in search for housing, please email 2020conclave@oppf.org. This is not a waiting list but a way to get a better gauge on how many Brothers are seek housing.

Also, we've received some questions regarding the room locations for meetings. As a point of clarification, we want to communicate to you that all official Conclave meetings will take place at the Tampa Convention Center.

Greetings Brothers,

The 2020 Grand Conclave in Tampa, Florida is experiencing unusually high demand. With a little more than 11 months before the 82nd Grand Conclave, we already have more than 2900 persons registered—making it the second largest non-centennial Conclave in Omega history. It is now projected to be the largest Conclave ever. As a result, the demand for housing in Tampa is also unprecedentedly high. As Omega makes additional accommodations to house our Brothers, we want to remind you of our housing policy:

Housing Policy:

No more than one hotel reservation may be made per registration. Rooms are reserved for registered brothers only. Any hotel reservations found to be out of compliance with this policy will be cancelled, with or without notice. This is not a new Omega policy. Previously, we have managed through the housing bureau; however, with the housing bureau no longer in place, we are now managing through housing committee. Per our contracts with the various hotels, Omega does have the right to cancel or move any reservation in its block. If you have a reservation in your name for another registered brother, please contact us <u>immediately</u> through the <u>2020conclave@oppf.org</u> email box to avoid having that reservation cancelled. Otherwise, all duplicate reservations will be cancelled even if you have one reservation in one hotel and another reservation at a different hotel.

These are exciting times for Omega that will require patience as we manage this extraordinary moment. More housing accommodations are being secured and you will be able to secure your room in the very near future. Congratulations on making the 82nd Grand Conclave historic!




