

Healthy Living Tips

From Dr. Tursha

Are You Being Fed??

That is not a rhetorical question. Are you being fed? Are you ACTUALLY eating? Like... food food. I don't mean just grazing or grabbing something on-the-go. I mean, are you actually eating and feed-ing your body?

Let me ask you this. Would you be ok with your child (or grandchild, or godchild, or elder parent) eating the way you have been eating the last several days? Weeks? Months? YEARS??

If the answer is "NO!" then I encourage you to begin to make some changes to how you feed yourself. Food is necessary, but the way you process the food is even more important because it impacts your digestion and absorption of the nutrients you need. In other words, if your body can't break the food down and get it in, then your cells still can't use it.

Make a resolution to yourself that you will improve ONE aspect of your meals each day. Don't make it complex, but you do need to make some effort. Here are some examples:

- Drink a Large Cup of Water as soon as you wake up
- Eat one meal at a table or at your desk instead of being on-the-go for each meal
- Before you eat, actually LOOK at your food for a couple minutes. Is it pretty? Does it smell delicious? Can you identify all the things?
- TASTE your food. Slow down while eating, don't just scarf it down quickly
- Eat (at least) one veggie a day.

These are simple, but they can be a great start to getting you and your body FED.


